Cultural traditions and language preservation are a sustaining factor for Mi'kmaw communities. Opportunities to explore, revitalize, share, and experience Mi'kmaw culture, both traditional and emerging, are vital to the long-term vitality of communities.

The objectives of this funding program are to:

- Support community-led Mawio'mi / Powwows
- Build the capacity of communities to host annual Mawio'mi / Powwows
- Support existing, annual/regularly occurring Mawio'mi / Powwows

Eligible Applicants

This fund is limited to Nova Scotia-based Mi'kmaw bands, the Native Council of Nova Scotia and the Mi'kmaw Native Friendship Society.

Funding

- Funding is intended to support costs associated with hosting and operating a community Mawio'mi / Powwow.
- There are two levels of funding:
 - Community Mawio'mi / Powwows with a total budget of less than \$60,000
 - Maximum funding request is up to \$5,000
 - Basic final reporting required
 - Community Mawio'mi / Powwows with a total budget of more than \$60,000
 - Maximum request is up to \$10,000
 - Moderate final reporting required
- There will be an annual deadline of each fiscal year, which will be posted and communicated in advance.
- Completed application forms can be emailed, delivered in person, mailed or faxed.
- Organizations must submit a **final report** within **60 days** of the event. If the final report becomes overdue, no funds can be released for any subsequent grants approved through the departmental until the overdue report has been received.
- The Province of Nova Scotia's and Support4Culture's support must be recognized as outlined in the *Requirements for Acknowledging Funding* which is available at:
