

Most Common In-Kind Rates for Donated Labour, Equipment & Material

(Approved OHVIF July 10, 2025)

Donated Equipment

Daily rate is applied when used for transportation (site inspection, signage, to and from work site, etc.)

Hourly rate is applied for continuous use such as brush cutting, repeated trips hauling materials etc.

OHV	• \$100/day • \$60/hour (towing trailer) • \$80/hour (towing mower)
Truck	• \$200/day • \$50hr transporting materials/equipment
Tow behind mower	• \$30/hour
Tractor	• Daily \$200 • Hourly -Min \$60hr
Attachments (add to tractor rate)	• Bush Hog \$30hr
	• Ditch Bank Mower/Side Mower \$35hr
	• Backhoe \$35hr
	• Back blade/Box Blade \$25hr • Wood Chipper \$35hr
	• Front End Loader \$20hr
	• Post Hole Auger \$20hr

In some cases, groups will claim some costs associated with donated equipment

To figure out eligible inkind when operating costs (fuel for example) are claimed as an expenditure use the following method.

Expenditures divided by hours of use = hourly operating costs

Subtract hourly operating costs from eligible hourly rate = eligible inkind hourly amount

Example

Tractor \$65hr

Operated for 50hrs, claimed \$500 for fuel/operating costs

500 divided by 50hrs = \$10hr operating costs

\$65hr eligible costs - \$10hr operating costs = \$55hr eligible to be claimed as inkind

Donated Labour

General Labour - \$35/hour

Skilled Labour

Chainsaw/Brushsaw/Polesaw	• \$50/hour (Operator using club supplied chainsaw) • \$60/hour (Operator who provides own equipment)
Welder	• \$70/hour (Operator using club supplied equipment) • \$90/hour (Operator who supplies own equipment)
Carpenter	• \$60/hour
Site Inspection/ Site Supervision/Project Management	• \$60/hour
